Notice of Brush Spray Program and Spray Program for Invasive Species

The County Road Commission Wants You to Know . . .

Right Way Control Services, 2580 - 104th Avenue, Zeeland, Michigan 49464, a licensed commercial applicator, has been contracted by the Van Buren County Road Commission to perform custom chemical (herbicide) vegetation control maintenance services along the right-of-way on various Primary Roads and Local Roads throughout Van Buren County. The control of brush along the roadsides is critical so as to maintain safe roadside vision.

Locations to be sprayed include invasive species control, as well as brush control at intersections and other selected areas within the county road right-of-way, EXCLUDING platted or urban areas, orchards and grape vineyards and certified organic farms that have been registered on the Michigan Specialty Crop Site Registry (DriftWatch). This application will begin after Labor Day.

The herbicide materials to be applied are may include Dicamba, 24D, Amino Pyralid, and Surfactant based upon species present at site. Invasive species control may include Imazapyr and Surfactant for phragmites, and Milestone and Surfactant for Japanese Knotweed.
