Tarachala gave an update in regards to the trailway project. Wightman & Associates has assigned a new engineer to work on the project and plans have been resubmitted to MDOT.

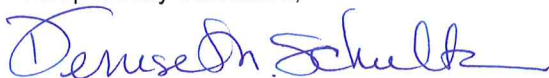
7. Comments and Communications Concerning Items not on the Agenda
