A. Discussion: Future Zoning Code Amendments

David Jirousek and commissioners discussed the following: low impact development, buffer restrictions, cluster development, maximum lot coverage and impervious surface, soil compaction, natural flow pathways, storm water and identifying natural features (ponds, trees on site plans). Guidelines/requirements could be added to Chapter II.2 and 11.6 for better definition and clarity of site plan. In addition overhead vs underground utilities was also discussed, with the interest in requiring new developments in commercial and subdivisions to bury utilities in the township.

B. Discussion: Future Zoning Map Amendments

David Jirousek discussed with commissioners three cases where property is being requested to be rezoned. 1.) Sid Longjohn, rezoning to GC on Red Arrow Hwy. and 25th 2.) John Bosker, rezoning to R-1 (including 5 parcels to the west). 3. Mark Lipson, Rezoning to GC (conditional) or text amendment. Options were discussed by commissioners.
