1. Call to order- Chairperson Daly called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm

- Roll Call- absent- Schultz. All others present. David Jirousek, LSL Planning and 2 guests.
- 3. **Approval of Minutes-** Motion Tarchella, Second Derhammer to approve minutes from June meeting as submitted. All voted in favor.
- 4. **Approval of Agenda-** Motion by Tarchella, Second Daly to approve agenda with addition of items 8A- Senior Services update, and 8B- Road funding update. All voted in favor.
- 5. Public comments on Agenda items- none
- 6. **New business** Site plan review: Eric Kausrud, West Point Realty, LLC, West Point Auto Building Expansion- Major Amendment. 24827 Red Arrow Highway (parcel #80-02-002-037-10).

Motion to approve site plan contingent upon the pending successful rezoning of the parcel to the south and receipt of site plan approval from the fire department.

7. Old Business-

- A. Trailway project update- Tarchella escorted Suzanne from Whiteman & Associates and Chip Kolowski of the DNR on a "ride along" to review phase one of the trail. DNR indicates that we will know if we will be receiving a grant from them in October. The grant would equal 50% of the funding to complete Phase One.
 - Grants of up to \$10,000 are also available from the Township's insurance company for signage on the trail.
- B. Future Zoning Code Amendments- Jirousek reviewed to areas that have recently come to the attention of the township for correction: changes to the temporary housing section of the ordinance and a correction on the definition of boarding houses. Planning commission agreed in general with the recommendation and Jirousek will now draft language for our review.

8. Communications-

- A. Senior Services has just completed the first year of funding and management of the program by the township. A very successful start, high participation and full transparency of spending as reported by Derhammer.
- B. Road funding may be changing in the way it is divvied up within the county. Money paid in by Antwerp may end up getting spent elsewhere. This is not a popular idea with the Township which has been communicated to the Road Commission. Action pending, reports Derhammer.
