

Van Buren County Veterans Health Services Program

(Program Start Date to be Determined Due to COVID-19 Pandemic)

WHO: All honorably discharged Veterans and current spouses who are Van Buren County Residents. Must have proof of residency (drivers' license, State ID, Passport, etc.), discharge papers (DD-214), and insurance cards, if any.

WHAT: In conjunction with the Van Buren Cass District Health Department (VBCDHD), Van Buren County is sponsoring Dental Care, Immunizations and Vision/Hearing Examinations to eligible Veterans and their current spouses subject to \$1,000 per person after private insurance, if any, is exhausted. A total of \$50,000 is available. This program will cease once the \$50,000 threshold has been met.

WHEN/WHERE/HOW: <u>TBD Due to COVID-19 Pandemic</u>. Registration at VBCDHD is required in order to determine residency and Veteran status. If eligible, a health care plan will be developed. Also, Veterans will be required to give permission for the Van Buren County Veterans Service Coordinator to contact them to inform them of Veteran Administration benefits they might not know exist. Veterans can contact the Veterans Services Coordinator directly if so desired. Appointments are **encouraged**.
